Sto godina od prvog počasnog doktorata Sveučilišta u Zagrebu

Hundred years since the University of Zagreb's first honorary doctorate

Počasni doktorat – *gradus doctoris honoris causa* – dodjeljuje se uglednim osobama koje su svojim radom pridonijele napretku Sveučilišta u Zagrebu, hrvatskoj znanosti i kulturi. Postupak dodjele pokreću obrazloženim prijedlogom pojedina sveučilišna tijela, fakulteti ili pojedinci. Senat imenuje stručno povjerenstvo i donosi konačnu odluku na temelju izvješća toga povjerenstva. Prema europskoj i hrvatskoj sveučilišnoj tradiciji dodjela počasnog doktorata izniman je događaj za sveučilište, a svaki počasni doktor osim časti i naslova prima na sebe čuvanje ugleda i dostojanstva sveučilišta. Diplome počasnih doktora svečanije su od ostalih diploma, pisane su latinskim jezikom, ovjerene potpisom rektora i promotora te opečaćene suhim žigom sveučilišta utisnutim u pečatni vosak.

Honorary doctorate – *gradus doctoris honoris causa* – is awarded to distinguished persons whose work has contributed to the advancement of the University of Zagreb, Croatian science and culture. The procedure of awarding the degree is initiated by university bodies, faculties or individuals by submitting a well reasoned proposal. The Senate then establishes an expert committee and makes the final decision based on the report compiled by the committee. According to the European and Croatian university tradition, the conferring of an honorary degree is an exceptional event for the university, and upon every honorary doctor are conferred not only the honour and the title, but also the duty to protect the reputation and dignity of the university. The diplomas awarded to honorary doctors are more ceremonious than other diplomas, they are written in Latin, authenticated with the signatures of the rector and promoter, and stamped with the University's dry seal impressed in sealing wax.

Sveučilište u Zagrebu, iako je na to imalo pravo od svoga utemeljenja 1669. godine, prvi je počasni doktorat dodijelilo tek 1913. profesoru Tadiji Smičiklasu, povjesničaru, zaslužnom javnom djelatniku, redovitom profesoru, dekanu, rektoru, predsjedniku Matice hrvatske i Jugoslavenske akademije znanosti i umjetnosti. Prijedlog za počasni doktorat dao je Proforski zbor Mudroslovnoga fakulteta. Senat Sveučilišta prihvatio je prijedlog i preko Kraljevske hrvatske zemaljske vlade zamolio dopuštenje cara i kralja Franje Josipa I. Rješenjem od 31. listopada 1913. vladar je dopustio *'da previšnje ime noseće sveučilište u Zagrebu može umirovljenog sveučilišnoga profesora i predsjednika jugoslavenske akademije znanosti i umjetnosti u Zagrebu Tadiju Smičiklasu u priznanje njegovih na polju historijskih znanosti stečenih zasluga promovirati na čast počasnoga doktora filozofije te mu izručiti doktorsku diplomu'*. Promocija je zbog bolesti obavljena 20. prosinca 1913. u njegovu stanu u Mesničkoj ulici. Osvrti na taj važni događaj objavljeni su 22. prosinca 1913. u dnevnom tisku².

Although the University of Zagreb had the right to award honorary doctorates since it was founded in 1669, it awarded the first such degree only in 1913, to professor Tadija Smičiklas, a historian, distinguished public official, full professor, dean, rector, president of Matica hrvatska and of the Yugoslav Academy of Sciences and Arts. The proposal to award him an honorary doctorate came from the Faculty of Philosophy's Teachers' Assembly. The University Senate accepted the proposal and, via the Royal Land Government, requested permission from the emperor and king Franz Joseph I to do so. In the decision dated October 31, 1913 the ruler approved that *'the highest university of Zagreb may, in recognition of his accomplishments in the field of historical sciences, confer the honorary degree in philosophy to the retired university professor and president of the Yugoslav Academy of Sciences and Arts in Zagreb Tadija Smičiklas and present him with the doctoral diploma'*. On account of Tadija Smičiklas' illness, the commencement ceremony was held on December 20, 1913 at his apartment in Mesnicka Street. The reports of this important event were published in daily newspapers on December 22, 1913.²

Do 1969. počasni doktori Sveučilišta u Zagrebu upisivali su se u *Knjigu doktora* u koju su se upisivali i svi ostali doktori Sveučilišta u Zagrebu, a od te godine ustrojena je posebna *Knjiga počasnih doktora*.

Do kraja Prvoga svjetskog rata dodijeljena su četiri počasna doktorata: profesoru Tadiji Smičiklasu (1913.), nadvojvodi Eugenu Habsburškom i generalu Svetozaru Borojeviću (na početku 1916.) te kanoniku Matiji Stepincu (1918). Nažalost, počasni doktorati nadvojvodi Eugenu i generalu Borojeviću iz političkih su razloga prešućeni u dosad objavljenim monografijama Sveučilišta³. Između dvaju svjetskih ratova (1920. – 1940.) dodijeljeno je četrnaest počasnih doktorata; a za Drugoga svjetskoga rata nije bilo počasnih doktorata.

Od 1945. do 1990. dodijeljeno je 48 počasnih doktorata na Sveučilištu i 14 na Katoličkom bogoslovnom fakultetu, koji je od 1952. do 1990. djelovao izvan Sveučilišta. Ugovorom iz 1996. priznate su sve diplome kao sveučilišne, pa je broj počasnih doktora u tom razdoblju 62. Valja napomenuti da je najviše diploma počasnih doktora, njih 29, vezano uz proslavu 300. obljetnice Sveučilišta 1969. i 1970. godine.

University of Zagreb honorary doctors were included in the *Book of Doctors*, which contained the names of all other University of Zagreb doctors, until 1969 when the separate *Book of Honorary Doctors* was established.

Four honorary doctorates were awarded by the end of World War I: to professor Tadija Smičiklas (1913), Archduke Eugen of Austria and General Svetozar Borojević (in early 1916) as well as dean Matija Stepinac (1918). Unfortunately, for political reasons honorary doctorates awarded to Archduke Eugen and General Borojević have been omitted from the University's monographs published in the past.³ Between the two world wars (from 1920 to 1940), the University awarded fourteen honorary doctorates; no honorary doctorates were awarded during World War II.

In between 1945 and 1990 the University awarded 48 honorary doctorates while the Catholic Faculty of Theology, which was not part of the University in the period from 1952 to 1990, awarded 14 honorary doctorates. As a result of the agreement signed in 1996, all degrees awarded by the Catholic Faculty of Theology were recognized as the University's, so the total number of honorary degrees awarded in that period is 62. It should be pointed out that the biggest number of honorary doctorates – 29 of them – was related to the celebration of the University's 300th anniversary in 1969 and 1970.

Godine 1930. doktorat profesora Gjuro Arnolda, nazvan 'zlatnim doktoratom' u povodu 50. obljetnice prvog doktorata na temelju pisane disertacije na našem sveučilištu (Gjuro Arnold *Etika i poviest*) uvršten je među počasne doktorate. Od 1991. do danas promovirano je 16 počasnih doktora, pa je ukupan broj nositelja toga najvišeg počasnog zvanja 96. Zadnji je dodijeljen 28. lipnja 2012. profesoru Mirjanu Damaški za doprinose razvoju znanosti i visokoškolskog obrazovanja u Republici Hrvatskoj.

Među počasnim doktorima samo su četiri žene: Dorothy Crowfoot Hodgkin (1969.), Marija s. Agnezija Pantelić (1988.), Margaret Thatcher (1998.) i Kathleen Vaughan Wilkes (2001.). Osmam počasnih doktora Sveučilišta u Zagrebu ujedno su i dobitnici Nobelove nagrade: Lavoslav Ružička (1940.), Vladimir Prelog (1952.), Niels Bohr (1958.), Robert Robinson (1960.), Werner Heiselberg (1969.), Dorothy Crowfoot Hodgkin (1969.), Jean Dausset (1986.), Linus Pauling (1988.) i Albert Fert (2008.).

In 1930, the doctoral degree awarded to Gjuro Arnold, referred to as 'golden doctorate' to mark the 50th anniversary of the first doctoral degree awarded by the University on the basis of a written thesis (Gjuro Arnold, *Ethics and History*, 1880) was included among honorary doctorates. Since 1991 to this day 16 honorary doctorates have been awarded; thus the total number of holders of this highest ceremonious title is 96. The last honorary doctorate was awarded to Professor Mirjan Damaška on June 28, 2012 for his contributions to the development of science and university education in the Republic of Croatia.

There are only four women among the University's honorary doctors: Dorothy Crowfoot Hodgkin (1969), Marija Agnezija Pantelić (1988), Margaret Thatcher (1998) and Kathleen Vaughan Wilkes (2001). Eight honorary doctors of the University of Zagreb are also winners of Nobel Prizes: Lavoslav Ružička (1940), Vladimir Prelog (1952), Niels Bohr (1958), Robert Robinson (1960), Werner Heiselberg (1969), Dorothy Crowfoot Hodgkin (1969), Jean Dausset (1986), Linus Pauling (1988) and Albert Fert (2008).

Najviše počasnih doktorata dodijeljeno je u području humanističkih znanosti (35), slijede društvene znanosti (15), prirodne (15), biomedicinske (12), tehničke (11) biotehničke (7) i jedan počasni doktorat (Branko Lustig) u umjetničkom području.*

*Valja istaknuti da su visoke škole prije ulaska u sastav Sveučilišta dodjeljivale počasne doktorate istaknutim osobama ali nisu upisane u knjigu doktora kao počasni doktori Sveučilišta. Tehnička visoka škola dodijelila je počasni doktorat Milanu Rojcu 1921., a Visoka veterinarska škola 1923. za zasluge pri osnivanju istih. Uz počasni doktorat Sveučilišta 1920. Milana Rojca možemo smatrati trostrukim počasnim doktorom našega sveučilišta. Visoka veterinarska škola dodijelila je 1923. počasni doktorat i Antoniju Vukoviću te Janku Rajaru.⁴

The highest number of honorary doctorates was awarded in the field of humanities (35), followed by social sciences (15), natural sciences (15), biomedicine (12), technical sciences (11) and biotechnology (7), while one honorary doctorate (awarded to Branko Lustig) was in the field of arts.*

*It should be pointed out that before becoming part of the University, colleges had awarded honorary doctorates to renowned figures but they were not included in the Book of Doctors as honorary doctors of the University of Zagreb. Milan Rojc was awarded an honorary doctorate from the Technical College in 1921, and from the Veterinary College in 1923 for his contribution to their founding. As the recipient of an honorary doctorate from the University in 1920, Milan Rojc can be considered a holder of three honorary degrees from our University. The Veterinary College also awarded honorary doctorates to Antonije Vuković and Janko Rajar in 1923.⁴

Tadija (Tade) Smičiklas

Reštovo na Žumberku, 1. listopada 1843. – Zagreb, 8. lipnja 1914.

Reštovo on Žumberak, October 1, 1843 – Zagreb, June 8, 1914

Osnovu školu polazio je u Sošicama. Godine 1853. primljen je kao pitomac u Grkokatoličko sjemenište u Zagrebu; maturirao je 1863. u Bogoslovnoj gimnaziji u Nadbiskupskom sjemeništu u Zagrebu. Nakon mature radio je kao učitelj u Osijeku i objavio svoj prvi rad. Studirao je povijest i zemljopis u Pragu i Beču uz potporu grkokatoličkoga biskupa Đure Smičiklase. Godine 1864. primljen je na bečki Institut za istraživanje povijesti, gdje se usavršavao u pomoćnim povijesnim znanostima.

Po povratku u domovinu 1870. godine radio je kao profesor povijesti u Riječkoj gimnaziji, a 1873. prelazi u Veliku gimnaziju u Zagrebu te odmah počinje surađivati u Matici hrvatskoj. Stalno je u vezi s poglavarima i pitomcima Grkokatoličkog sjemeništa, u kojem je od 1877. do 1882. obnašao dužnost ravnatelja. Godine 1882. objelodanio je prvi dio *Povijesti hrvatske* (724 str.), a drugi već 1879. (486 str.), dakle obrnutim redoslijedom.

He attended primary school in Sošice. In 1853 he was accepted as a student at the Greek Catholic Seminary in Zagreb; he graduated in 1863 from the Theological Gymnasium at the Archbishopal Seminary in Zagreb. After graduating he worked as a teacher in Osijek and published his first work. He studied history and geography in Prague and Vienna with the support of Greek Catholic Bishop Đuro Smičiklas. In 1864 he was accepted at the Institute of Austrian History Research in Vienna, where he studied auxiliary sciences of history.

Upon returning to his homeland in 1870, he worked as a professor of history at the Rijeka Gymnasium. In 1873, he transferred to the High Gymnasium in Zagreb and immediately began working at Matica hrvatska. He maintained constant connection with students and superiors at the Greek Catholic Seminary, where he held the post of the head of seminary from 1877 to 1882. In 1882 he published the first volume of his work *Croatian Histories* (724 pages), while the second volume was published in 1879 (486 pages), prior to the first volume.

Njegova *Poviest* prva je cjelovita sinteza hrvatske povijesti do 1848., pisana na temelju arhivske građe. To djelo bilo je odlučno za njegov izbor na sveučilišnu stolicu hrvatske povijesti. Godine 1882. postao je redovitim profesorom na Mudroslovnom (Filozofskom) fakultetu. Pored glavnog predmeta predavao je i pomoćne povijesne znanosti. Običavao je održavati i 'historijske vježbe', koje su podrazumijevale rad sa studentima na različitim vrstama izvora. Već 1883. izabran je za pravog člana JAZU-a, danas HAZU. Neke svoje povijesne rasprave objavljuje u *Radu JAZU*. Od 1900. do smrti 1914. djelovao je kao predsjednik Akademije, a od 1890. kao predsjednik Matice hrvatske, te je za njegova predsjednikovanja proslavljena 50. obljetnica Matičina rada.

Dužnost dekana Mudroslovnoga fakulteta obnašao je akademske godine 1886./1887., a sljedeće akademske godine, 1887./1888., izabran je na dužnost rektora Zagrebačkog sveučilišta kao četrnaesti rektor. Na rektorskoj inauguraciji održao je govor 'O postanku Osmana'. Sljedeće akademske godine, prema ustaljenom postupku, imenovan je prorektorom.

His *Histories* were the first comprehensive synthesis of Croatian history up to 1848, written on the basis of archival records. This work was crucial in his appointment to the university chair in Croatian history. In 1882 he became full professor at the Faculty of Philosophy. In addition to teaching the main course, he also taught auxiliary sciences of history. He also used to hold 'history practice exercises', which included working with students on various types of sources. Already in 1883 he was appointed a member of the Yugoslav Academy of Sciences and Arts (JAZU), today the Croatian Academy of Sciences and Arts (HAZU). He published some of his historical discussions in *Rad*, a journal published by JAZU. From 1900 to his death in 1914 he was the president of JAZU, and he had also been the president of Matica hrvatska since 1890. During his time as president, Matica hrvatska celebrated its 50th anniversary.

In the academic year 1886/1887 he performed the duty of the dean of the Faculty of Philosophy. In the following academic year of 1887/1888 he was elected to be the 14th rector of the University of Zagreb. At the Rector's Inauguration he delivered the speech 'On the Origin of Osman'. The following academic year, in line with tradition, he was appointed Vice-rector.

Za *Spomen knjigu Matice hrvatske* (1892.) izradio je dragocjene biografije nekoliko istaknutih hrvatskih povjesničara i političara. Pripadao je Neodvisnoj narodnoj stranci, bio je pristaša i poštovatelj Račkog i Strossmayera. Od 1883. do 1887. i od 1897. do 1902. zastupnik je u Hrvatskom saboru, pa iz toga doba potječu njegovi brojni saborski govori. Pokrenuo je 1904. i do smrti uređivao *Diplomatički zbornik kraljevine Hrvatske, Dalmacije i Slavonije*, kodeks srednjovjekovnih isprava. Umirovljen je 1905. na vlastitu molbu.

Njegova bibliografija od 1865. do 1914. ima 153 jedinice, a nakon smrti do 1990. tiskano je još deset njegovih radova. Bibliografija radova o Tadiji Smičiklasu objavljenih od 1875. do 1992. sastoji se od 167 jedinica.⁵ Riječ je o iznimno plodnom autoru, sveučilišnom profesoru, zaslužnom javnom djelatniku, domoljubu i dobrotvoru.

He wrote valuable biographies of several prominent Croatian historians and politicians for the *Matica hrvatska Memorial Book* (1892). He was a member of the Independent People's Party and a follower and admirer of Rački and Strossmayer. From 1883 to 1887 and from 1897 to 1902 he was a member of the Croatian Parliament, and his numerous parliamentary speeches date from that period. In 1904 he launched the *Diplomatic Codex of the Kingdom of Croatia, Dalmatia and Slavonia*, a codex of medieval documents, which he was the editor of until his death. He was retired in 1905 at his own request.

His bibliography for the period from 1865 to 1914 consists of 153 works. After he died, an additional 10 works were published in the period to 1990. The bibliography of works about Tadija Smičiklas published from 1875 to 1992 consists of 167 works.⁵ He was an exceptionally prolific author, university professor, distinguished public official, patriot and philanthropist.

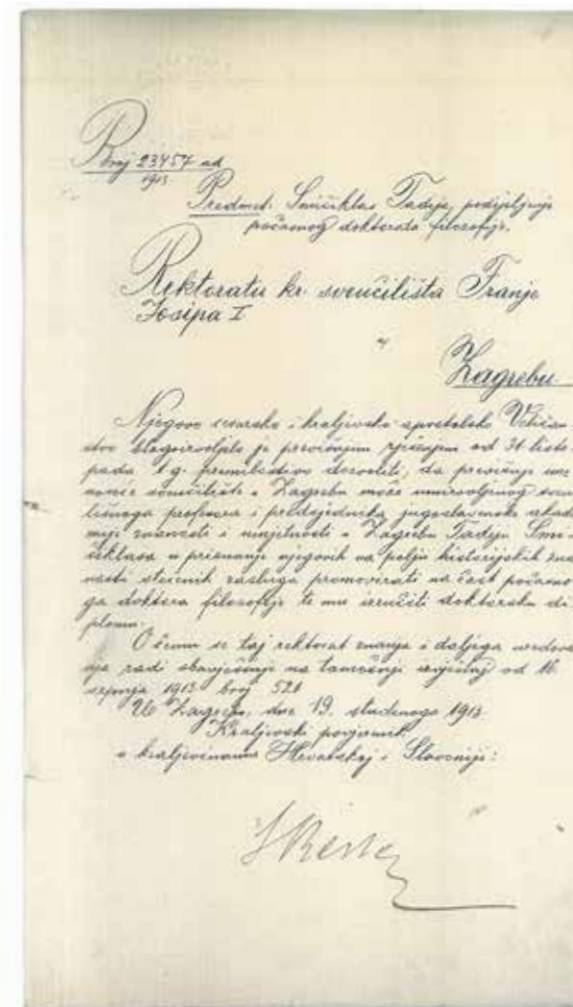

Mudroslovni fakultet uputio je 15. srpnja 1913. molbu Akademičkom senatu Sveučilišta riječima 'kako je najveći i najznatniji dio kulturnoga nastojanja prof. T. Smičiklasa vezan uz ovo sveučilište, nadala se od sebe misao, da bi sveučilište najdostojnije proslavilo njegovu 70 godišnjicu, da mu kod te zgrade uruči diplomu svoga začasnoga doktora'. Senat je zamoljen da se predstavkom obrati Zemaljskoj vladi 'da kod Njegova Veličanstva izbori ovlast, da rečenu diplomu smije izdati T. Smičiklasu'.⁶ Rješenje vladara uslijedilo je 31. listopada 1913., a promoviran je 20. prosinca 1913. u svojem stanu jer se zbog bolesti promocija nije mogla održati u auli Rektorata Sveučilišta. Umro je sljedeće godine u lipnju u 71. godini života; pokopan je u arkadama na zagrebačkom groblju Mirogoj.

On July 15, 1913 the Faculty of Philosophy submitted a request to the University's Academic Senate, pointing out that 'since the biggest and most significant part of cultural endeavours of Professor T. Smičiklas are tied to this University, the thought presented itself that the best way for the University to celebrate his 70th birthday would be to award him the degree of honorary doctor'. The Senate was asked to send a request to the Land Government to 'obtain authorization from His Highness to issue the said degree to T. Smičiklas'.⁶ The ruler's decision followed on October 31, 1913 and Smičiklas was made honorary doctor on December 20, 1913 at his apartment, since it was not possible to hold the commencement ceremony at the University Rectorate due to Smičiklas' illness. He died the following year aged 71; he was buried in the Arcades at Mirogoj graveyard in Zagreb.






Počastni doktorat Tadije Smičiklasa.*

Profesorski je zbor mudroslovnoga fakulteta povodom sedamdesetgodišnjice života predsjednika Jugoslav. akademije presv. gosp. Tadije Smičiklasa jednoglasno zaključio, da se nekadanji njegov odlični član i neumorni radnik na polju hrvatske historiografije, odlikuje dozvolom Njegovog Veličanstva, počastnim doktorom filozofije u našem sveučilištu. Prema tomu zaključku predložio je također jednodušno akademički senat kr. zemaljskoj vladi, da se to odlikovanje na Previšnjem mjestu izhodi. Kako je bilo u svoje vrijeme već objavljeno, Previšnjim je rješenjem od 31. listopada t. g. doista dopušteno, da se Tadija Smičiklas u priznanje njegovih zasluga na polju historijskih znanosti stečenih zasluga promovira na čast počasnog doktora filozofije u našem sveučilištu, te mu uruči doktorska diploma. No još prije nego je to rješenje stiglo, predalo je presv. gosp. T. Smičiklasu posebno odaslanstvo, koje se sastojalo od ovogodišnjega rektora dra. Ede Lovrića, zagrebačkoga gradonačelnika Janka Holjca i ravnatelja grčko-katoličkog sjemeništa dra. Dionizija Nyaradia adresu zavoda, u kojima je on naučao i djelovao i gradova, kojih je on začasnim građaninom. A gradski načelnik gosp. Janko Holjac predao je ujedno tom zgodom svečaru umjetno izradjenu plaketu u ime grada Zagreba. Diploma počasnoga doktorata filozofije uručena je svečanim načinom Tadiji Smičiklasu dne 20. o. g. po promocijalnom povjerenstvu sastojecem se od ovogodišnjega rektora dra. Eduarda Lovrića, ovogodišnjeg dekana u mudroslovnom fakultetu dra. Julija Golika i promotora kr. jav. redov. profesora dra. Gustava Janečka. U 12 sati odputilo se iz sveučilišta promocijalno povjerenstvo, u svojim insignijama uz pratnju pedela sa sveučilišnim žezlom u stan promovenda, gdje ga je rektor dr. Lovrić oslovio govorom u kojem mu je izrazio veliku radost sveučilišta, da može počastiti svoga bivšega rektora, dekana i profesora mudroslovnoga fakulteta najvećom akademičkom čašću, koja se samo riedkim izabranicima daje radi izvanrednih njihovih znanstvenih zasluga,

a u red ovakovih izabranika već odavno ubraja hrvatska nauka i znanost odličnoga svečara. Presv. gosp. Tadija Smičiklas najtoplije se zahvalio na ljubavi, što mu ju je filozofski fakultet i akademski senat izkazao, izhodiivši da ga hrvatsko sveučilište odlikuje počastnim doktoratom. Na to se je gospodin svečar sa članovima izljubio. Tako su ponovno dokumentirane velike znanstvene zasluge Tadije Smičiklasa s Previšnjega mjesta, pošto mu je već god. 1910. podieljen po Njegovom Veličanstvu austro-ugarski počastni znak 'Za umjetnost i znanost' kojim je jedini on u našoj domovini odlikovan.
